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**THE SCHOOL**

Mission College Preparatory Catholic High School is nestled in one of the happiest cities on the continental United States –San Luis Obispo (Time Magazine, 2017)—along California's Central Coast. MCP is a comprehensive college prep school with an academic program intended to provide an inspiring formative education, set within a nurturing environment that facilitates student exploration and discovery of their best, truest and most capable selves as a catalyst for success throughout future academic, professional, civic, religious and family initiatives. Creating a culture of care and accountability in partnership with families, Mission College Prep guides students along a path of scholarship, inspiration and leadership to form women and men for others. Current enrollment is approximately 310 students. MCP boasts a robust curriculum comprised of over 50 college prep courses approved and certified by the University of California, meeting "a-g" core and elective requirements.

**THE CURRICULUM:  
ACADEMIC PROGRAM**

MCP teaches 80-minute periods on an alternating block schedule. Students may take up to seven classes with an eighth period available for Flex activities such as Guidance Workshops, Advisement, school rallies/assemblies and Mass. Five units are awarded for each semester class passed with an A, B, C or D. During each 18-week semester, students may take a maximum of 35 units. We offer an academically challenging curriculum with 6 Honors courses and 13 Advanced Placement classes. We also offer courses in leadership, drama, health, well-rounded electives and Catholic Theology. Over 60% of the faculty has more than 18 years of teaching experience and the average class size is 19.

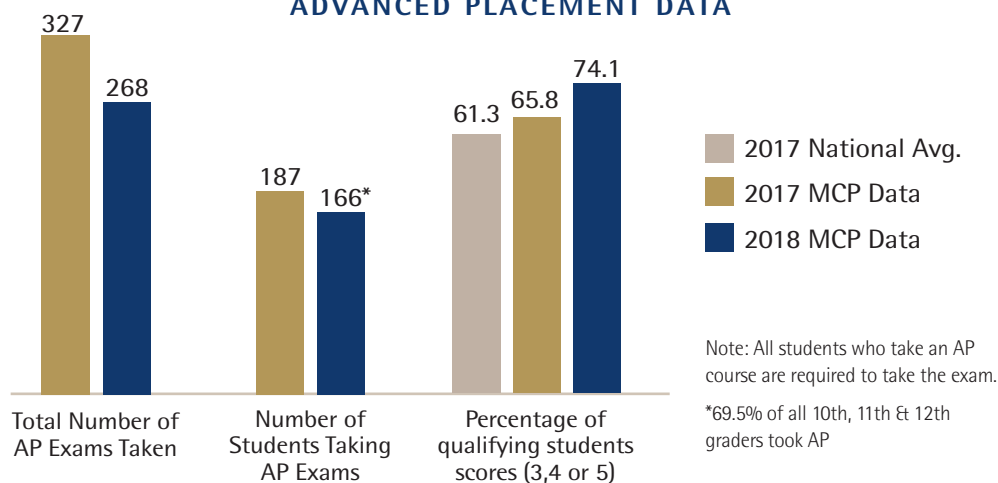

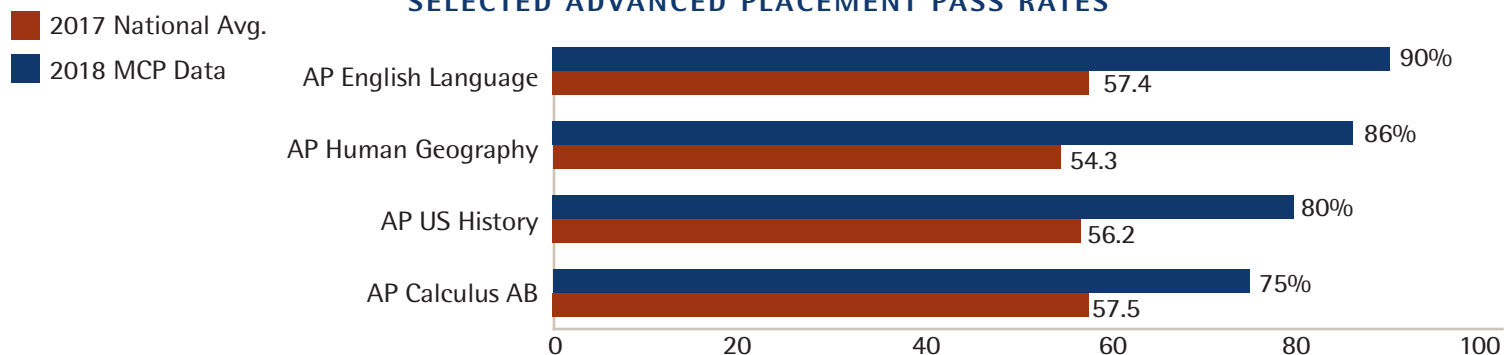
